EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S MESSAGE

CASH IN TIMES OF CRISIS

As the world experiences increasing uncertainty - both geopolitical and economic - we need to remind others that in such times people look for tangible, familiar and 'secure' value as well as liquid

Cash meets that test. While it continues to be under threat in many countries, central banks have started to recognise that notes and coins must continue to be part of the transaction system.

As we have indicated previously there remains not only many unbanked people in the world but also many who just don't or can't use digital, as well as those who now have been displaced or disconnected.

As we now know, the European Central Bank Governing Council, recognising the possibility that retailers may try to stop accepting cash at point of sale, adopted the Eurosystem's Cash 2030 strategy with four specific goals:

- 1. Ensure the provision of an efficient and robust supply of cash
- 2. That euro banknotes and coins continue to be universally accepted by merchants
- 3. That there is the continuation of the provision of safe, state-of-the- art euro banknotes and coins recognising their significance as a symbol of European Integration


